For this purpose, we put a team of 3 experts, specialized in production, international sales, business development and/or communication at your service.

The possible work areas are: ready-to-wear, jewellery, leather goods, shoes, accessories...

We offer two types of guidance:

1. TRIAXES Mode « Study »

One year guidance by three experts.

2. TRIAXES Mode « Pre-prototype »

Support in the development of a three

The conditions for these two services are identical:

Conditions for participation to the TRIAXES Mode program:

- Your company's head office is located in the Brussels-Capital Region.
- Possession of a VAT number.
- Financial participation:
 - The project leader (you) must make a financial contribution of 600 € for the entire one-year participation.
 - The project leader can pay his participation in two terms of 300 € per 6 months of support. The cost of the programme is 600€.
- To be independent or to represent an organization with less than 10 employees.
- To initiate an innovative project.
- Comply with the rules on the cumulation of subsidies (minimis).

The advantages of the TRIAXES Mode program:

- A simultaneous expertise of three professionals: 1 production expert, 1 international sales expert and 1 business developer and/or communication expert.
- A professional audit on the economic and technological validity of your project.
- Preliminary work on the project that shortens the R&D time.
- Collaborative work, which increases the relevance of your project's ecosystem analysis.
- Learning from a collaborative work methodology.
- 1 year of guidance by three experts.
